

## Chicago Pet Policy and Restrictions

### Policy

For all Chicago properties, Mac charges a one-time, non-refundable fee of \$350.00. All owners of a dog must provide an up-to-date shot record.

The rent below covers two (2) pets max limit per unit and not per pet.

- High-rise properties – 35.00 per month (Regents, Shoreland, Algonquin, Del Prado, Blackwood, EPT, Windermere House, Sutherland, City Hyde Park, Solstice on the Park)
- Walk-up properties (neighborhood/garden) - \$25.00 a month

### Breed Restrictions

The following lists the dog breeds (including any mix) that are restricted from all Mac properties.

### Other Pets

Description of animal(s): Only the animals described below are allowed in the dwelling. Neither resident(s) or guest or occupants may bring any other animals(s), reptile, bird, amphibian, fish, rodents, or insects into the dwelling or apartment community.

Cats are accepted at all of our properties and are subject to the pet fee and rent charges.

### Restrictions by Property

Only the properties listed below have further restrictions. Dogs only allowed in buildings/floors listed below:

- East Park Tower – No Dogs are allowed
- Windermere House- Dogs allowed on 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor Only
- Algonquin – Building 4 & Building 5
- Blackwood – All Floors
- Shoreland – Floors 2-6 and 13
- Del Prado – Even floors
- Regent's Park – South Tower

### Assistance Animal(s)

As defined in the HUD 4350.3 Occupancy Manual, assistance animals are animals that work, provide assistance, or perform tasks for the benefit of a person with a disability, or animals that provide emotional support that alleviates one or more identify symptoms or effects of a person's disability.

If a prospect/lessee is confirming they have an assistance animal, the Assistance Animal Verification Form must be filled out and returned. This verification form has to be filled out by a Medical Professional for confirmation. Once completed, the pet administrative fee(s) and rental charge are not applicable. If the owner has an assistance animal, they must provide the animal's up-to-date shot record.
